

EU Film Festival “Europe on Screen 2023” successfully close with 234 film screenings.

The 23rd annual European Union (EU) Film Festival “Europe on Screen (EOS) 2023” successfully wrapped up after an exciting 10 days of 234 film screenings in 7 major cities across Indonesia. More than 20 film professionals from Europe and Indonesia also participated in-person and virtually in the festival’s side events this year.

“The Europe on Screen 2023 Film Festival has come to an end. From 16 to 25 June, we showed 73 top level feature and short films touching a diverse collection of topics that took the audience across 24 European countries. The EU is proud to hold 234 film screenings and to host thought-provoking discussions with European and Indonesian film professionals,” said H.E. Vincent Piket, EU Ambassador to Indonesia, at the EOS 2023 Closing Ceremony on 25 June at Erasmus Huis, Jakarta.

“Employee of the Month”, a dark-comedy film from Belgium, officially closed EOS 2023. The film, directed by Véronique Jadin, won the Audience Award from Fantasy Filmfest 2022. The film presents a bitter but hilarious corporate culture, with a good dose of comedy and thrilling action.

“Thanks to this festival, Europe in all its diversity is better known in Indonesia”, said H.E. Frank Felix, Belgian Ambassador to Indonesia, prior to the screening of the closing film.

“This year, the number of screenings for EOS 2023 increased by 25% compared to the previous year. The enthusiasm from our audiences propels us to, at least, try to increase the number of screenings every year,” said Nauval Yazid, EOS 2023 Festival Co-Director.

In addition to the film screenings and film talks held after several screenings, four European film professionals – Marco Martani (Italy), Alexander Bak Sagmo (Denmark), Lolita Del Pino (France) and Miriam Antognazza (Italy) – delivered in-person or online workshops prior to and during the festival.

Three winners of the EOS Short Film Pitching Project (SFPP) 2023 were also announced during the closing ceremony. A total prize of IDR 108.5 million were awarded to the winners.

“As an international film festival, we created SFPP to support the Indonesian film industry and to open the door for film co-production. The SFPP total prize pool of IDR 108.5 million of funds, access to post-production facilities, trainings and goods provided by EOS, SAE and Kemala Home Living will help winners to realise their projects and learn new skills for future productions,” explained Meninaputri Wismurti, EOS 2023 Festival Co-Director.
